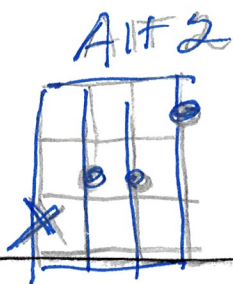


Intro: Sing and play Line 4  
*single* strum until Last F

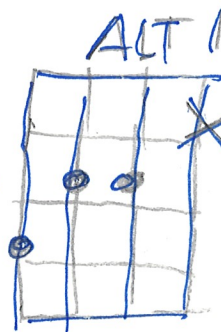
Solo 1: Line 3 (bars 1-4)
