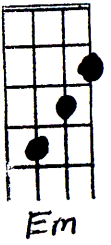
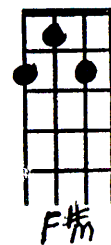

 Could it be the devil in me or is this the way love's supposed to be....

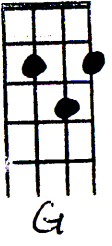
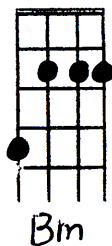
